

RESIDENTIAL SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK
May 1 - 9, 2010

Use of the landfill site will be free of charge from May 1 to May 9 inclusive for residents of the Township of Terrace Bay. Landfill site will open Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Saturday and Sunday from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. Regular hours will resume on Monday, May 10th. Public Works will do townsite pick-up from residential properties May 3 to 6 inclusive. Pick-up applies to residential properties only, commercial and business properties are not included.

There will be no pick up of tires or demolition material. Large quantities of concrete will not be picked up (i.e. sidewalks or old foundations). Tires, demolition material or concrete can be delivered to the landfill site by the property or business owner and regular rates will apply. Demolition material includes roofing material, dismantled garage or shed, etc.

Residents are asked to place rubbish close to the roadside, in proper containers where necessary, to permit easy access for loading.

Freezers or refrigerators require certification that refrigerant has been removed before they will be accepted for pick-up or disposal at the landfill site.

Owners of large items on residential property who wish to dispose of same free of charge should contact the Public Works Department at 825-3315 not later than Tuesday, May 4.

Pick-up of large items will be done only on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of clean-up week.

DON'T FORGET THE ANNUAL TERRACE BAY HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY to be in Fall 2010 for the following materials: paint/stains, single-use batteries, car batteries, propane tanks, pesticides, fertilizers, computers, monitors, televisions, fax machines, printers, mice, wires, and keyboards. Please hold on to these materials until the Fall so we can send them away to be recycled!

PLEASE NOTE: Public Works will not pick up derelict vehicles, i.e. old cars, trucks or trailers. These items can be delivered to the landfill site by the owner and no tipping fees will apply.
