# **Dock and Boat Launch Area Rules & Regulations – Under COVID-19**




#### General

All users must observe the following rules to ensure the safety of everyone:

- ➤ Launch users **MUST** maintain physical distancing of at least two metres (2m) at all times.
- ➤ Dock users and shoreline anglers **MUST** maintain physical distancing of at least two metres (2m) between individuals.
- ➤ It is recommended that Passengers/anglers in boats should be limited to those who reside in the same household. Nonfamily/non-household members in the same boat need to practice proper physical distancing.
- ➤ The dock surfaces, railings and seating areas are currently not sanitized or cleaned regularly. All users should take proper precautions and wash hands or sanitize after any contact.
- ➤ Restrooms are available but are only cleaned and sanitized once a day. All users should take proper precautions and wash hands or sanitize after any contact.

# PHYSICAL DISTANCING

## **KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE**

For prevent the spread of COVID-19 3315 maintain a **2 metre (6ft)** distance

### Launching

- 1. Upon arrival at the launch, park your vehicle in the parking area to prepare your boat to launch.
- 2. Vehicles and trailers must be parked with a minimum two metre (2m) distance between.
- 3. When it is your turn to launch, head to the ramp area and launch your boat. Only one (1) boat to launch at a time. Secure your boat to the dock, while you return your vehicle to the parking area.
- 4. Park vehicle and return to your boat. Leave the launch area and head out to the Lake.
- 5. You MUST wait your turn to complete the launch/load process if another boater is ahead of you, remain at your vehicle in the parking area until they have completed their launch/load and have vacated the area.

### Loading

- 1. Upon returning to the launch, assess if there are other boats launching or loading. If there is a boat ahead of you, you MUST wait until the ramp is clear.
- 2. Secure your boat to the dock and retrieve your parked vehicle. Boats should be moored
- 3. Back down the ramp and load your boat onto the trailer. Only one (1) boat to load at a time.
- 4. Return to the area to complete any tasks required before safely leaving the beach area.
- 5. You MUST wait your turn to complete the launch/load process if another boater is ahead of you remain in your vehicle in the parking area until they have completed ALL steps in the launch/load process and have vacated the area.
