



Weekly Terrace Bay Waterfront Development Construction Update

28 September – 2 October, 2020

Please be advised that...

- The new boardwalk will end at the gazebo site location, which has been cleared this week. The construction of the gazebo will be considered in the near future.
- Electrical power is being connected to the pavilion building,
- Contractor is working on the roof system,
- The pavilion building continues to be framed,
- Wells are being drilled for potable water and geothermal heating,
- Contractor is receiving and storing construction materials within the construction zone,
- Access to the boat docks and launch remains open throughout the season,
- The Township will be removing docks at the end of September,
- General public has access to the beach area that is not included in the construction zones,
- Camping is **not allowed** on Terrace Bay Beach,
- Overnight parking for vehicles and boat trailers **is allowed** in designated areas only (i.e. parallel parking to the edge of the road and stall parking by the docks),
