

Weekly Terrace Bay Waterfront Development Construction Update

26 - 30 October, 2020

Please be advised that...

- With all the work being done, be aware of a busier construction site as several more subcontractors are currently working onsite,
- Construction continues on the boardwalk around the building,
- The new boardwalk will end at the gazebo site location, which has been cleared. The construction of the gazebo will be considered in the near future,
- Doors and windows of the pavilion building are being installed,
- Electrical power and power meter are being connected to the pavilion building and inspected by the Electrical Safety Authority (ESA),
- Contractor is working on the roof system,
- The pavilion building continues to be framed and strapped in preparation of stone work,
- Wells are being drilled for potable water and geothermal heating,
- Contractor is receiving and storing construction materials within the construction zone,
- The Township will be removing docks next week, 2-6 November, 2020,
- General public has access to the beach area that is not included in the construction zones,
- Camping is not allowed on Terrace Bay Beach,
- Overnight parking for vehicles and boat trailers **is allowed** in designated areas only (i.e. parallel parking to the edge of the road and stall parking by the docks).
