



Weekly Terrace Bay Waterfront Development Construction Update

January 6th – January 20th 2021

Please be advised that...

- Current project schedule indicates project will be completed in April/May 2021
- Construction contractor returned to the work site this week and will continue throughout the winter/spring season
- Construction continues on the boardwalk around the building
- The new boardwalk will end at the gazebo site location, which has been cleared. The construction of the gazebo will be considered in the near future
- Windows and doors of the pavilion building have been installed
- Contractor continues to work on the roof system; the metal roof and soffit are being installed
- Contractor has completed the stone work
- Wells are being drilled this week for potable water and geothermal heating.
- Back-up propane heating system has been installed
- Electrical power has been installed to the building
- Contractor is receiving and storing construction materials within the construction zone,
- General public has access to the beach area that is not included in the construction zones,
- Camping is **not allowed** on Terrace Bay Beach,
- Overnight parking for vehicles and boat trailers **is allowed** in designated areas only (i.e. parallel parking to the edge of the road and stall parking by the docks).
