

Weekly Terrace Bay Waterfront Development Construction Update

June 28th 2021

Please be advised that...

- Recreation Staff painted existing washroom and added new bench on the docks
- Current project schedule indicates project will be completed in a couple weeks
- Building inspection is in the proves of providing building occupancy
- Construction of Boardwalk #2 is completed
- Beach Donation Fish has been installed
- Youth Initiative Regional Beach Direction sign is complete and installed
- Boardwalk lighting is nearing completion
- The new boardwalk will end at the gazebo site location, which has been cleared. The construction of the gazebo will be considered in the future
- Public Works is in the process of improving the parking lot and expanding the east end
- Washrooms are complete
- Wells have been connected to potable water and geothermal heating.
- Final mechanical systems have been commissioned
- Back-up propane heating system is complete
- Building outside lighting is complete
- Contractor has removed the construction area zone
- General public has access to the beach area that is not included in the construction zones,
- Camping is **not allowed** on Terrace Bay Beach,
- Overnight parking for vehicles and boat trailers **is allowed** in designated areas only (i.e. parallel parking to the edge of the road and stall parking by the docks).
