



# Campsites along the Trail

Campsites on the Casque Isles Hiking Trail include the following amenities, unless noted;  
Bear Box, Picnic Table, Fire Ring and Thunderbox or Outhouse.

Campsites are on or near a water source, filtration is your responsibility.

Carry out what you carry in, the Bearboxes are meant for food storage not garbage.

Do not burn refuse in the fire pits as this also leaves your garbage on site.

Campsites are listed west to east, Rosspoint to Terrace Bay.

We do not manage a reservation system, it is first come first serve.

1. Km 6.5, McLean's Creek - No Bear Box. A smaller site for 2 or 3 small tents.
2. Km 8.5, near large pond. A smaller site for 2 or 3 smaller tents.
3. Km 13. Rainbow Falls Prov. Park, Whitesand Campground - No Bear Boxes. A Prov. Park with a full Comfort Station. A permit is required from the Gatehouse.
4. Km 23. Twin Harbours, on shore of Lake Superior. A medium site for 3 or 4 smaller tents.
5. Km 26, on shore of Lake Superior. A small site for 2 or 3 smaller tents.
6. Km 27. Schreiber Beach, on shore of Lake Superior - No Fire Ring. A large site for more than 4 small tents. Camping is allowed between the pillars in front of the Gazebo or on the Beach. Anywhere else is Private Property.
7. Km 30. Fourth Lake, near small inland lake. A small site for 2 or 3 tents.
8. Km 33. Worthington Beach, on shore of Lake Superior - No Bear Box. A large site for more than 4 small tents.
9. Km 39. Les Petits Ecris Beach, on shore of Lake Superior. A medium site for 3 or 4 smaller tents.
10. Km 41 on Island of Tombolo, on shore of Lake Superior. A small site for 2 or 3 small tents.
11. Km 49. Lyda Bay Beach, on shore of Lake Superior - No Bear Box, Fire Ring or Thunderbox. A large site on the Terrace Bay Nature Reserve for more than 4 small tents.
