- Should be 16 years of age
- Experience as a lifeguard or instructor an asset

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Report to Swim Pool Team Lead. Perform other duties as assigned by the Team Lead.
- Is responsible to plan, organize and implement swim lessons at all levels which will include:
 - Preparing long range and daily lesson plans as advised by Swim Pool Team Lead
 - Keeping progress records and continuous evaluation for all swimmers
- Ensure safety and maintain high safety standards at all times for all patrons.
- Ensure a fun, safe and healthy aquatic experience, providing excellent customer service.
- Required to instruct swim lessons and lifeguard.
- Requires working flexible hours including early mornings, evenings, weekends and holidays
- Required to assist in any maintenance or other such tasks as assigned by the Team Lead.
- Is responsible for maintaining a good public image for the facility, for maintaining good public relations and to promote aquatics in the Town of Terrace Bay.
- Required to attend and participate in pre-service training, in-service training and staff meetings.
- Required to keep in good physical condition through practice and participation in in-service training sessions.
- Required to wear proper aquatic uniform while on duty.
